The Murrieta Rod Run gears up to rumble through Historic Downtown Murrieta for their 6th Annual Car Show!

The Rod Run is being hosted by the Drifters Car Club of Southern California and will benefit Oak Grove Center.

The popular car show and fundraiser is scheduled for Friday, October 12th and Saturday, October 13th. It kicks off with a Friday Night Cruise at 4:00 pm and is followed by the “Show and Shine” on Saturday starting at 9:00 am. With more than 400 cars expected to be on display, over 50 vendors, raffle baskets and a 50/50 opportunity drawing, this is not only a great event for the classic car enthusiast, but for the entire family. This is a free event that is open to the public and has grown exponentially each year. More than 30,000 people are expected to attend this year over the two days.
