Oak Grove Center is a nonprofit organization serving at-risk and special needs youth through Residential Care, Education and Treatment.

POPULATION SERVED:

Children and adolescents ages 8 through 18 for the residential program, and 5-22 for school programs. Oak Grove specializes in treating children experiencing social, emotional and behavioral disturbances, mental illness or substance abuse, and those

SPECIAL EDUCATION NON-PUBLIC SCHOOL:

traumatized by child abuse and neglect.

Jack Weaver School and Oak Grove at the Ranch are both California State certified non-public special education programs for grades 1-12. Students may earn a high school diploma, certificate of completion, or GED/high school proficiency. Case management and therapeutic programs, electives and an arts and sports program are provided.

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Programs



RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT:

A therapeutic program for boys and girls (ages 8-18) requiring intensive 24 hour care. Residential treatment includes individual, group and family therapy, psychiatric evaluation and medication monitoring, special education, recreational therapy and milieu therapy. Residential milieu therapy offers a variety of specialty groups and inclusion in the Arts program. Partial Hospitalization and Intensive Outpatient services available for those who do not require daily 24 hour care or used to transition from residential treatment.

DAY PROGRAM & DAY TREATEMENT PROGRAM:

Available to students whose Individualized Education Programs (IEP) specify this level of care. A therapeutic program with ongoing case management, group therapy, and crisis intervention as well as many opportunities for enrichment and elective activities.

AUTISM SERVICES:

Oak Grove offers classes that serve students primarily identified with Autism or other students who would benefit from this specialized program. Classrooms focus on building communication skills, social skills, self-help skills, mobility, safety awareness, work habits, and sensory integration /regulation.

Community-Based Programs

WRAPAROUND:

Wraparound provides comprehensive, community-based services and support to assist families as they work toward reunification or to in order to help the child remain with their families and communities. Oak Grove provides Wraparound services throughout Riverside including our newest location at Oak Grove in the Desert in Bermuda Dunes.

THRIVE:

Oak Grove is proud to be the Independent Living Skills Program (ILP) provider for Riverside County. THRIVE provides weekly workshops and individualized Life Coaches to help youth ages 16-21 learn necessary skills for self-sufficiency.

OAK GROVE SANCTUARY PALM SPRINGS:

A transitional housing program for Non-Minor Dependents (THPP-NMD) specifically designed to meet the needs of LGBTQ+ community foster youth transitioning to adulthood.

Additional Services

WORKABILITY:

Provides students 14 years or older with vocational education and job placement with community-based businesses. This includes our <u>Culinary Arts Vocational Program</u> where youth earn culinary certificates, gain employment experience and build customer service skills.

SPECIALTY WORKSHOPS/GROUPS:

Oak Grove offers additional evidence-based workshops and specialty therapeutic services such equine



therapy, pet therapy, anger management, parenting workshops, commitment groups, recovery/relapse prevention and more.

ANCILLARY THERAPIES AND SERVICES:

Related treatment services included are Recreation/Activity Therapy, Drug/Alcohol Education, Speech and Language Therapy, Special Diets and Emancipation Programming.
